

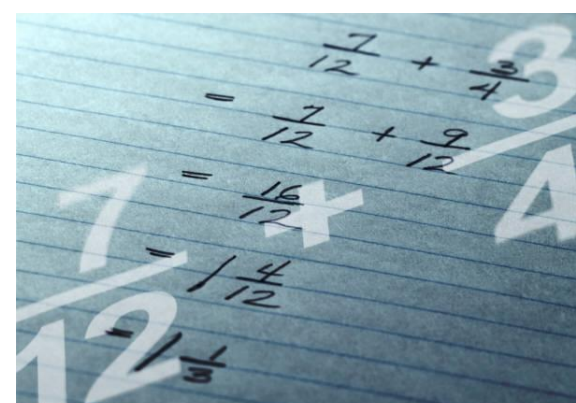


Fraction Through Music

$$\frac{2}{4} = \frac{4}{8}$$

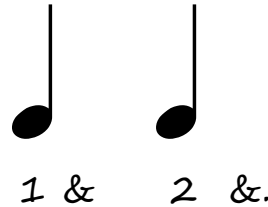

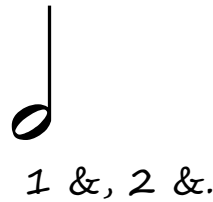

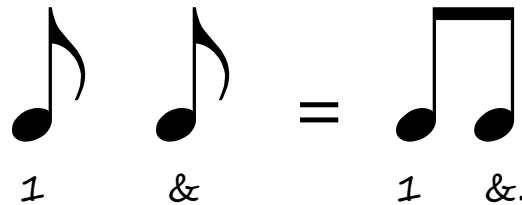
$$\frac{1}{4} + \frac{1}{4} = \frac{2}{4}$$

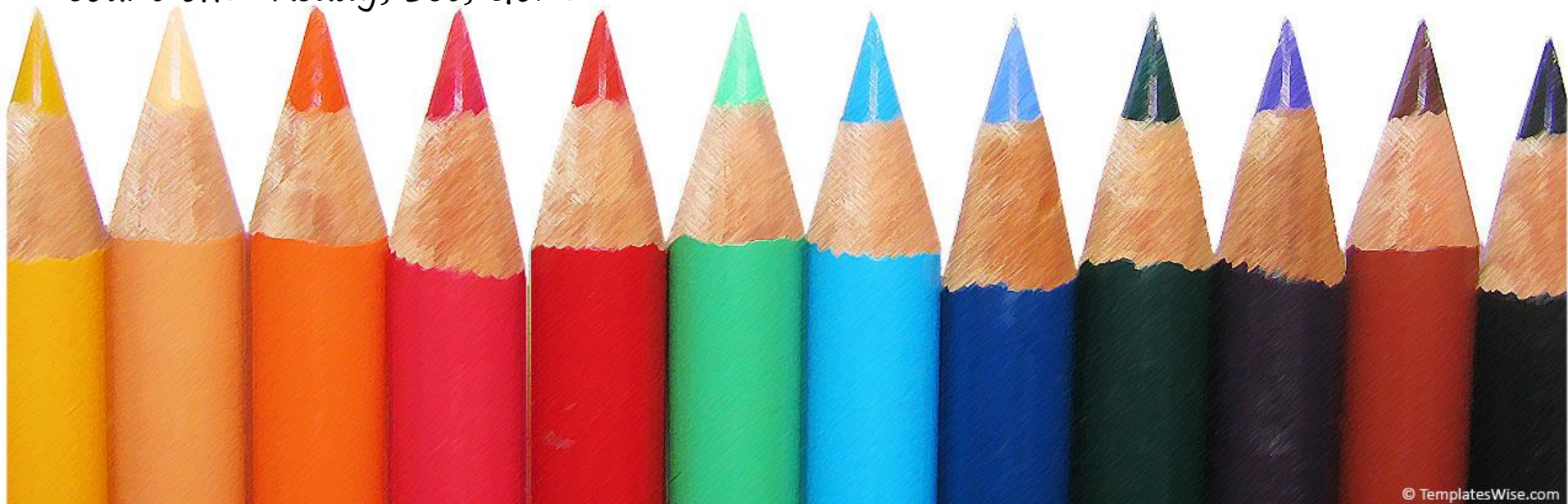


Fraction Music Game

(For this part you can work with one friend or a group of friends)
You get to play 3 musical pieces. One is going to be the correct answer and that will be equal to 1 beat just like a quarter note or two eighth notes. Play the other two musical pieces longer for 2 – 4 beats.

As the music is performed, ask your friend(s) to keep counting in their head along with each musical piece. Remind your friend that the eighth note is equal to only $1/2$ count ($1/2$ beat).

Before you start to play, please tell your friend which musical piece you will play, for example: "Example A" and start your music with a count off: "Ready, Set, Go!"
