



Lesson Variation

Two Groups Play And One Group Counts The Movements



Guided steps: How to play music in a classroom.

(Review)

Step 1.

Remind students of an important rule: when they play a musical piece, they should:

“Start together, stay together and end together!”

Step 2.

Each musical piece should start with:

“Ready, Set, Go!”

(This helps students to establish the steady beat).

Here is the musical piece with musical movements:
("T" is for a tap, "S" is for a snap, "C" is for a clap).

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Challenge of counting the movements!

Step 1. Divide the class into 3 groups.

Step 2. Tell Group One that they are going to do "T" for taps, Tell Group Two they are going to do "C" for claps and Tell Group Three they are going to do "S" for snaps.

Step 3. Tell Group Three that they are not going to play, but they will count Group One and Group Two's movement together.

Step 4. Perform the piece without Group Three, "S" (Review page 2).

Step 5. Write the correct answer on the Board.
