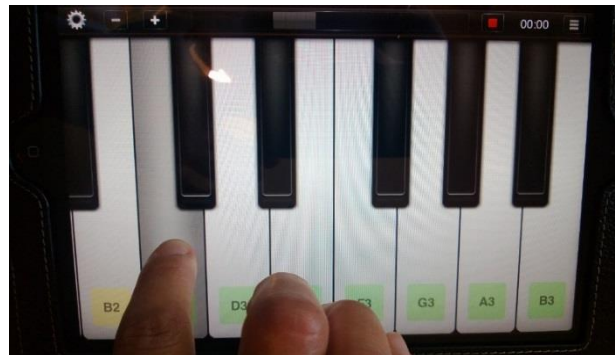
Piano Fingering Chart
